What is the job market

- Matching employers & job candidates through face to face interviews (modeled on ASSA meetings)
- Institutions advertise jobs; PhD candidates apply, sending packages w/ job market paper & letters
- Institutions screen & make short list for interviews
- Interviews in December
- A subset of candidates invited for flyouts, typically in Jan.-Feb.
- Job offers and negotiation
- Market clears, typically in March

Why a European job market

Current situation:

- US job market (ASSA meetings, early January): some European institutions participate. However, for many the cost is high relative to prob. of hiring
- Spanish job mkt: 2nd week of Dec.
 - Well attended by students
 - Employers mostly from Spain
- UK job mkt: 3rd week of Dec.
 - Employers mostly from UK (and not all UK institutions go)
- Many European employers do not go to any market!
- → Jobs not available beyond local pool of applicants

Benefits of a European job mkt

For institutions that did not go to any mkt:

- Hire from a broader pool of candidates → better matches
- Internationalization

For institutions that go to ASSA:

- More interviews, improved screening
- Credible signal of candidates' interest for job in Europe

For PhD candidates:

Many more interviews than in ASSA alone
